

Rocklin Pony Baseball Terms & Conditions accepted during player and volunteer registration

# **Birth Certificates**

Birth Certificates are required for all new players registering with the league. Copies may be sent into the PO Box, or emailed to registrar@rocklinponybaseball.com. Returning player's birth certificate information is on file and is not required each year. Copies may be required for All Star Play.

## **Residency Address Verification\***

Rocklin Pony Youth Baseball requires residency verification. New and returning league members must send in a copy of the most current utility bill showing residency. This applies to Rocklin residents ONLY. Copies may be sent into the PO Box, or emailed to registrar@rocklinponybaseball.com.

### School ID for Non Rocklin Residents\*

Any players that do not live in Rocklin but attend schools in the RUSD or charter school within the city limits, are asked to send in a copy of the players school ID card, or a print out showing school registration. Copies may be sent into the PO Box, or emailed to registrar@rocklinponybaseball.com.

\*Non Rocklin Residents or Non Rocklin School attendees, only need to send Birth Certificates if new player to league.

#### League Fundraiser

As part of my registration I agree to pay the \$50 Rocklin Pony Youth Baseball League Player Fee. The Fee may be offset by participating in the RPYB League Fundraiser.

### Program Terms & Conditions

I. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS As the legal guardian of the registered player, I hereby give my approval to participate in any and all PONY League activities. I will furnish a certified copy of a birth certificate for the registered player to league officials. I understand that participation in any league fundraisers is mandatory. I authorize the league to acquire, distribute or utilize photos of my child for the purpose of league marketing, promotions and fundraising opportunities. If paying registration by check, should your check be returned, it will be subject to a returned check processing fee of \$25.00. I agree and understand that I have ordered the correct jersey size and will not be able to return or exchange it. II. I agree to volunteer eight hours per registered player to the League's Snack Bar. I will pay the \$200 deposit per child (up to \$400 per family) towards my parent participation hours, due by my team meeting. I understand that upon my completion of my 8 hours each, I will receive my deposit refund (check returned). III. PERMISSION FOR TREATMENT AND MEDICAL RELEASE As the legal guardian for the above-named player, I do hereby grant permission for my minor child to be treated for any accident or emergency condition that occurs in my absence as deemed appropriate by the adult Manager, Coach, League Official and/or Team Mom. I realize that reasonable efforts will be made to contact me as soon as possible. This permission includes necessary first-aid provided by the above-noted persons. The information as stated on this form may be provided to a Hospital or Emergency Medical Care Physician. This authorization shall include all league activities, including the period required to travel to and from those activities; and we do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the Rocklin PONY Baseball Organization, Pony Baseball, Inc.: the organizers, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting the player to and from those activities, for any claim arising out of an injury to the player, so named on this form. IV. REFUND POLICY There will be a 25% administrative fee charged on all registration refunds-requested in writing. All refund requests must be received in writing prior to the first date of workouts. No refunds will be issued after that time. This includes any late registrations accepted by the league. The last day of refunds is the last day of refunds. V. PARENT, PLAYER, SPECTATORS AND VOLUNTEERS CODE OF CONDUCT Parents and Spectators will be positive role models, display and instill in all players, the principals of good sportsmanship and team play, conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players, do their best to provide the players a positive experience, make certain that their children show respect for all other players, coaches, officials and spectators, agree not to ridicule or demean players, coaches, umpires, or league officials in any public

forum, agree to inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of their child, agree to treat all players, coaches and umpires fairly and with respect, comply with the decisions of league officials, support the rules, regulations and bylaws as established or endorsed by the Rocklin Pony Baseball organization, not question an umpire's call, respect the opponent and avoid any confrontation with opposing players, spectators, or coaches, be drug and alcohol free while at any Rocklin Pony athletic event, and will not use abusive or profane language. Players shall display good sportsmanship and team play at all times, follow the direction of the coaching staff, respect all coaches, players, league officials, umpires and spectators, make every attempt to be on time and ready to play for all games and practices. Players shall not use abusive or profane language, taunt or humiliate any other player, question an umpire's call, abuse, mistreat or mishandle any Rocklin Pony equipment or property (e.g., throwing batting helmets). Consequences -- All members of the Organization are subject to consequences which may lead to discipline or possible termination as deemed necessary by the Rocklin Pony Youth Baseball Board of Directors due to failure to comply with the Code of Conduct. All members agree to abide by these rules as part of their registration in the program. It is the responsibility of all members to be familiar with the guidelines set forth in the Code of Conduct. VI. I understand and agree to the Policy and Procedures as set forth by the Rocklin Pony Youth Baseball Board of Directors.

### Concurrent League Rule, adopted as of Spring 2015 Season:

Players registered with RPYB may not also be registered with another concurrent recreational baseball league (such as Little League, other Pony league, etc) at any point in the season. Once RPYB learns of a player in another recreational league concurrent to the RPYB schedule, RPYB will immediately notify the player's parents with notification of this rule. If the dual registrations are discovered prior to the RPYB draft (Pinto and above) or team placement (Shetland), the parents will be given an opportunity to choose between the leagues with a full refund available should they leave RPYB. Parents choosing to remain with RPYB must immediately notify the other league of their cancellation of registration. RPYB may request documentation of the registration cancellation at its discretion. Parents choosing to not participate in RPYB will be refunded their paid registration fees as long as the registration is canceled prior to the player's placement on a team. If the dual registration is discovered after placement on a RPYB team, parents electing to leave RPYB will receive no refund. Parents will have 48 hours from RPYB notification, or before placement on a team (whichever comes first) to inform RPYB of their decision. Failure to respond to the RPYB contact by the deadline will result in removal from RPYB.

#### Volunteer Deposit

I agree to participate as a volunteer in Rocklin Pony Baseball. A \$200 deposit will be collected per child (up to \$400 per family) and held until the completion of all the volunteer hours.

This season teams (3 to 4) will be assigned a week to cover the snack bar. The team parents of the assigned teams will get together and made a schedule for the families to work.
